The logo comprises various features that uphold the continuous development of the students in the country.
- 2. The new logo features the following elements:
 - a. DepEd Bukidnon Logo: (DM No. 222, S. 2023)
 - b. Sun: A sun symbol conveys various meanings, often associated with positive attributes and aspirations such as enlightenment and knowledge, where the sun is a symbol of light and enlightenment, suggesting the pursuit of knowledge and education within the student government. It also shows leadership and guidance. It can represent the student government's role in guiding and leading the student body toward a brighter future. It symbolizes energy and enthusiasm reflecting the vibrant and active nature of student involvement in governance. The sun's warmth and light symbolize inclusivity, representing a welcoming and open environment for all students. A sun signifies optimism and hope, conveying the student government's commitment to creating a positive and hopeful atmosphere on campuses. Lastly, it can also symbolize empowerment, indicating that the student government empowers to shine and make a difference.
 - c. Laurel Wreath: Laurel Wreath represents purity, eternity, devotion and triumph that brings hope in the dark, no matter how hard the way.
